Footnotes

LOVELY VIN was well rated while setting the pace through slow fractions, responded well when set down in upper stretch, extended the advantage into the final furlong and just held under strong urging. UP AND OUT OF SITE went six then five wide on the first turn, settled in the middle of the field, chased three wide on the far turn, pursued the winner under a drive and closed well late but missed. MAN OF STRIFE was unruly in the gate, got turned around and put both legs over the pontoon, thrashed around for a while, was backed out and deemed fit to run, went three wide on the first turn, settled off the pace, advanced four wide on the far turn and got up for the show. BEAUTY'S PIONEER went three wide on the first turn, settled towards the rear, was urged along while four wide on the far turn, came five wide into the stretch and improved position. PELHAM was very rank into the first turn, swerved five wide then dropped to four wide, settled off the pace, went three wide on the far turn, came four wide into the stretch and also improved position. HENRY'S TEDDYBEAR went five then four wide on the first turn, tracked the pace on the outside, chased on the far turn, drifted out while tiring in the stretch and gave way. HIGH HOPES E DAY was a bit rank early while under a tight hold, went four then three wide on the first turn, was reserved off the pace, bumped with CHOCTAW BILL leaving the backstretch, came under urging while off the rail on the far turn and failed to rally. ARKANSAS MARTINI angled in early, lingered near the back while towards the inside and failed to threaten. BECKYBOY settled in the middle of the field, raced off the rail on the turns and failed to respond. CHOCTAW BILL was well placed just off the pace, bumped with HIGH HOPES E DAY leaving the backstretch, saved ground into the stretch and came up empty. THE WOLF IS BACK lagged well back and showed little. LEMON SHERBERT was rated on the inside, came up empty on the far turn and retreated. GUSTAV BAY angled in towards the rear, raced well back in the field and was outrun. (Rail at 0 Feet)
