LUCKY TRADITION broke alertly, set the pace along the inside while rating in the early going, asked along to maintain advantage into the second turn, shook off a couple of rivals turning for home and steadily increased advantage through the lane. PRINT forwardly placed moved closer and lodged a mild bid three wide late in the final turn, could not match the winner in the drive, remained well clear for the place. CHOCOLATE SOLDIER lacked early foot, asked for run in the second turn, moved to the outside for the drive, finished up best of the rest while remaining well out in the strip. UNCLE JOSH lacked speed, lodged a middle move to loom a threat four wide late in the final turn, flattened out in the drive. BACK OFF SATAN last away, trailed in the early going, passed tiring foes. IMATITANTOO was evenly paced while racing just off the inside, had little for the drive. JOHN'S BROWN BEAR four wide into the first turn, moved closer before a half, pressured the winner from the outside, gave way in the drive. MOUNT NEBO pressed, stopped far turn.
