Footnotes

HANDLEMAN never far back, moved up to challenge the leader from the outside late in the turn, long drive, fully extended while drifting slightly. SCENE OF THE CRASH broke sharp, cleared to the inside, set the pace, responded when challenged by the winner and gave ground grudgingly to that foe, remained clear of the others. URBAN JUNGLE last away, raced back for three furlongs, improved by racing toward the inside into the stretch, moved out slightly, finished willingly to be getting to the top two. KING CRIMSON allowed to settle within striking distance, three wide, came up empty for the drive. LITTLE LIZARD off the rail early, swung out turning for home, lacked a significant response when asked. SWEETSOUTHERNMOON four wide into the turn, six wide while getting out exiting the bend, remained back. DUBLIN ROAD pressured the runner up from along the inside early, in tight, checked up into the turn, fell back and did not recover. ARREDONDO trailed throughout.
