Weights: Thursday, November 19, 2009. Starters to pass the entry box by the usual time of closing. Field will be limited to 14 starters should race not be split. High weights on the scale will be preferred. Different owners have an equal draw according to weights. Horses having common ties through ownership cannot start to the exclusion of a single interest. Failure to draw into the race will cancel all fees. A trophy will be presented to the owner of the winner. Closed Saturday, November 14, 2009, with 14 nominations.

EUROEARS broke with the field, soon took over, bit of a breather early in the turn toward the inside, shook off the other speed when straightened for home, held sway under steady handling. TEMPO FIVE crossed to the inside behind the two leaders soon after the start, stalked into the stretch, moved out and was steadily gaining on the winner late. TEND last to leave, trailed in the early going, carried out a bit to be four wide late turn, moved inside and was along for the show while not a threat to the top two. SOK SOK evenly paced while in the three path much of the way, lacked a closing bid. SOUTHERN STYLE closest to the winner, applied a marginal amount of pressure through the turn, gave way in the drive. MARVEL WOOD not a serious threat. PREMIUM WINE was also always outrun.
