**Footnotes**

GOING TO THE SUN raced inside on the first turn, was well placed just off the pace, came three wide into the stretch, moved out outside the three-sixteenths pole, rallied to the lead inside the furlong marker and edged clear under steady handling. TOKEN DIVA raced three wide on the first turn, was forwardly placed on the outside, made a bid with three furlongs to run, led into the final furlong but was quickly headed and outfinished while just able to get the place. MAESTRO MISS settled between rivals while never far back, raced near the rail on the far turn, came out a bit in upper stretch and lacked the needed kick while able to get the show. MUFFIN was reserved off the pace, eased her way out on the backstretch, moved closer with a half-mile to run, went three wide on the far turn and lacked the needed response. NANA KNOWS raced three wide on the first turn, took the lead with six furlongs to run, vied inside on the far turn and tired. NOW AND FOREVER shifted three wide late on the first turn, settled on the outside, was urged while four wide on the far turn and failed to threaten. CHERRY PINK raced three to four wide on the first turn, lagged near the back and failed to respond. AD LITEM set the early pace, relinquished the lead with six furlongs to run, raced up close near the inside, came up empty on the far turn and stopped.
