BLADING GOLD RING forwardly inside, fell back a bit in the turn, angled out to be three wide turning for home, challenged, long drive, proved best under firm handling. CROSSFIREHURRICANE set or forced the pace off the inside, vied between foes into the stretch, stretch duel the final furlong, held stubbornly, clearly second best. TUSCAN CHIANTI off bit slow, forced out to be six wide out of the turn, no match top two, up for the show. MALAWI with the pace for over a half, weakened in the late going while closest to the inside. PASSION TAMER bobbled at the start, not a threat. MISS DIANE stumbled badly at the start, raced back, was making a mild advanced when forced out to the eight path turning for home, did not recover. KIP THE TIGER off the early pace, lodged a mid move four wide to forced a pair of rivals well wide turning for home, gave way soon after.
