**Footnotes**

RICE CLIMBER went three wide on the first turn, settled off the slow pace, raced outside of HARVEST HOME on the far turn, moved out in upper stretch then bobbed, rallied into the final furlong, battled with MUSICSTREET MENACE and prevailed under strong handling. MUSICSTREET MENACE raced four wide on the first turn, was rated on the outside, engaged the leader while three to four wide on the far turn, was asked in upper stretch, led into the final furlong, battled with ICE CLIMBER late and was outfinished while able to secure the place. CARSON CONNECTION bumped with a rival at the start, was reserved off the pace, jostled with ITS MR SLEW TO YOU near the seven-sixteenths pole, raced three wide while ridden along on the far turn, moved out in the stretch and finished willingly for the show. ITS MR SLEW TO YOU broke inward at the start, lagged at the rear of the field, moved up inside the half-mile pole, jostled with CARSON CONNECTION near the seven-sixteenths pole, raced between rivals on the far turn and lacked the needed kick. HARVEST HOME bumped with rivals on both sides at the start, was well placed just off the pace, raced near the rail on the far turn, came between rivals in upper stretch then lacked the needed response. NIGHT VISION settled on the inside, saved ground through the far turn and failed to rally. KHUKURI bumped with a rival at the start, raced three wide on the first turn, was rated behind the leader, gained a short lead while two to three wide on the far turn, was asked in upper stretch, vied into the final furlong and gave way. CEDROS was reluctant to load, set the pace on the inside through sluggish fractions, vied into the stretch and dropped out. (Rail at 0 Feet)
