DIAMOND BENZ bumped with a rival at the start, contested the pace on the outside, inched clear at the top of the stretch and drew away under steady urging. KNIGHT OF HONOR contested the pace on the inside of the winner, chased that rival in upper stretch and proved no match while clear for the place. BELL'S MAMBO broke out at the start, was urged along on the outside, raced three then four wide on the turn and got up for the show. TIME FOR COFFEE moved up to race just off the pace, dropped back while off the rail on the turn and weakened. MORENO STAR bumped with a rival at the start, was urged along while off the pace, raced two then three wide on the turn and failed to threaten. UNCLE BRAW was well placed just off the pace, dropped back while inside on the turn and came up empty. KAIZER TOP broke a bit slow, settled on the inside, saved ground on the turn and failed to respond.
