Footnotes

CANADIAN MISTRESS moved clear late on the first turn, set the pace through solid fractions, responded well when put to a left-handed whip in upper stretch, switched to a right-handed whip near the furlong marker and was all out to last under strong urging. BELOVEDA was taken back behind CANADIAN MISTRESS midway through the first turn, moved to the outside of that rival, tracked down the backstretch, chased on the far turn, pursued the winner determinedly in the stretch but missed while well clear for the place. CHICALALEE bumped with a rival at the start, raced three wide on the first turn, settled towards the rear, saved ground while urged along on the far turn and was best of the rest. FLEUR DE SEL settled on the inside, was roused while off the rail on the far turn, moved out inside the quarter-pole and came up empty. SURPRISE THE DEVIL was bumped in the hindquarters at the start, went two then three wide on the first turn, settled on the outside, dropped back while three then four wide on the far turn and faded. BARBY SUE dropped to the inside on the first turn, lagged at the rear of the field, saved ground on the far turn and failed to threaten.
