### Footnotes

IDE BALL contested the pace on the outside, vied two to three wide on the turn, gained the lead in upper stretch, moved clear under right hand urging, switched to a left-handed whip near the sixteenth-pole and proved much the best under good handling. HIT THE ROAD LEE contested the pace on the inside of the winner, lost the lead in upper stretch and proved no match while just able to hold the place. SPARKLING KEAT was well placed behind the leaders, chased two then three wide on the turn, came four wide into the stretch and narrowly missed the place. BLUEHARD was urged along while off the pace, raced three then four wide on the turn and failed to threaten. SILENT PIPE was urged along on the outside, raced four then five wide on the turn, came six wide into the stretch and was no factor. MR. PORTER was urged along while off the pace, raced two to three wide on the turn and faded.
