ROCK HARDER went two then three wide on the first turn, settled off the pace, advanced two then three wide on the far turn, drifted in a tad while taking the lead in upper stretch then drew away under steady urging. SEWANEE settled on the inside, saved ground through the far turn and narrowly earned the place while no match for the winner. FLASHY SUNRISE bobbed at the start, raced three then two wide on the first turn, settled towards the rear, was urged along while two then three on the far turn, shifted out at the top of the stretch and narrowly missed the place. HERO OF ORDER set the pace through solid fractions, lost the lead in upper stretch and gave way. ST MOOSE bumped with a rival after the start, raced five wide into the first turn then dropped to four wide, moved to three wide late on that turn, settled on the outside, went four wide early on the far turn, dropped to one off the rail around the three-eighths pole and failed to rally. JULIUS CAESAR went four wide on the first turn, lagged near the back while on the outside, went four to five on the far turn and failed to threaten. BRIGADE went three wide on the first turn, pressed the pace, chased two to three wide on the far turn and tired. AL MUSADDAD brushed with a rival entering the first turn, dropped to the inside on that turn, settled in third position, was urged along while inside on the far turn and came up empty. PAROLED bumped with a rival after the start, brushed with another rival while four wide entering the first turn, dropped in shortly thereafter, settled off the pace, was urged along while three then four wide on the far turn and had nothing left.
