POLISH AFFAIR close up, bid from the inside, took over inside the final sixteenth and proved clearly best. GRANNY'S PRIDE sprinted clear early, was collared nearing mid stretch and while no match for the winner held second safe. LADOMA out footed early, split foes around the turn and then showed late interest. GOLD MARGARITA off last, advanced steadily off the rail, bid outside turning for home and then did not have enough late. FIRST APPROVAL chased GRANNY'S PRIDE until turning for home and then weakened. HUMBLE LANE raced inside and lacked a finish. OUI OUI CHEROKEE raced back to the drive, was steered out and closed mildly. CATERETTE raced wide and was outrun. ROYAL STRATEGY was never dangerous. HONEY ISLAND slow away, hustled up before the turn and then faltered. ONE PERFECT SAILOR showed speed to the drive and then gave way. TIME TO BUY dropped back.
