**Footnotes**

EASY STING raced two then three wide on the first turn, settled just off the pace on the outside, advanced three wide on the far turn, gained the lead near the three-sixteenths pole, inched clear into the final furlong and held under right hand urging. BAN DAN bumped with a rival at the start, dropped to the rail on the first turn, settled near the inside, went three wide on the far turn, dropped in while advancing in the vicinity of the five-sixteenths pole, moved to the inside entering the stretch, shifted out outside the furlong marker and closed gradually but failed to overtake the winner. BRAVE DAY moved to the early lead, raced off the rail on the first turn, set the pace through solid fractions, controlled the action while inside on the far turn, lost the lead near the three-sixteenths pole and tired while able to hold the show. PIANO RULES was last away, raced three wide on the first turn, lingered well back in the field, went two then three wide on the far turn and improved position. DOO WAP DADDY bumped with a rival at the start, raced three wide on the first turn, prompted the pace on the outside, failed to respond when asked near the quarter-pole and gave way. D MITTEN bumped with a rival at the start, was hustled and given one crack of a right-handed whip, went three wide on the first turn, settled in the middle of the field, was urged along while off the rail on the far turn and failed to rally. TONAIRE was bumped on both sides at the start and pinched back, dropped well behind the field while near the inside and never reached contention. LONE STAR PIE settled on the inside, saved ground on both turns and failed to respond. CASTNET KENT raced just off the pace while on the inside, came up empty on the far turn and stopped.
