WHERE'S CAIN vied up front while between foes for most of the opening half, disposed of the other speed when straightened for home, clear, held the runner up safe late. SEVEN MILE BRIDGE in the second flight early, moved out to be five wide turning for home, lost some ground to the winner, getting back to that one late. TACKY ANGEL lacked speed, raced four wide out of the turn, angled out, finished up willingly well out in the strip. SEA THE SOLDIER behind the leaders turning for home toward the inside, in a tight tight upper stretch, got through but lacked a closing bid. FREEBIE GOLD vied up front while widest of the first group, tired in the drive. PERSONAL VELOCITY lacked a late bid. XPECTTOOWIN vied up front closest to the inside and faltered. KAHUNA remained back. GOOD FIGHT tired while five wide.
