Footnotes

DE ENFORCER came away in good order, went three then four wide on the first turn, settled nicely on the outside, moved closer leaving the backstretch, was asked while four wide on the far turn, rallied to the lead in upper stretch and drew clear under right hand urging. ANEXECUTIVEOPENING set the pace through moderate fractions while off the rail, was set down at the top of the stretch, lost the lead outside the furlong marker and proved no match for the winner but just held the place. PILOT JON saved ground on the first turn, settled towards the rear, was ridden along while three wide on the far turn, swung five wide into the stretch, came out a bit after straightening, held a good striking position into the final furlong but lacked the needed kick then just missed the place. AFRODITA went three wide on the first turn, tracked the pace on the outside, made a bid while three wide on the far turn, battled under a right-handed whip in upper stretch and tired. MEH YEAH was hustled from the start, contested the early lead then was eased back off the pace while on the inside, settled just behind the pacesetter, was urged along on the far turn, saved ground into the stretch and came up empty. GIACOMORE was restless in the gate, hesitated at the start, lagged at the rear and showed little. BIG BOY PETE drifted out at the start then was asked some, went four then five wide on the first turn, moved in outside the five-eighths pole then advanced inside a rival, came up empty on the far turn and stopped.
