Footnotes

CINDY'S REBEL chased the pace, raced inside on the turn, came off the rail at the top of the stretch, gained the lead nearing the furlong marker and drew clear under steady urging. ROBIN'S SPORT brushed with a rival at the start, set the pace, raced inside on the turn, lost the lead near the furlong marker and proved no match for the winner while clear for the place. BRING THE WOOD was ridden along while off the pace, raced off the rail early on the turn, shifted four wide in the vicinity of the five-sixteenths pole, came under the whip in upper stretch and lacked the needed response while best of the rest. ALBA DABBA DOO was ridden along towards the back, raced off the rail on the turn and improved position without threatening. ROLL OF THE DICE brushed with a rival at the start, was urged along while off the pace, raced three to four wide on the turn, shifted five wide nearing the quarter-pole and failed to threaten. NOPE was ridden along near the back, saved ground on the turn and was no factor. BOY DOG chased the pace on the outside, raced mostly three wide on the turn and tired. LEGIONS GIFT was ridden along in the middle of the field, dropped to the inside on the turn and failed to respond. BIG THORN was ridden along at the back while on the outside, went five to six wide on the turn and faltered.
