Footnotes

HERECOMESBERT brushed with a rival at the start, contested the pace on the outside then three wide on the turn, was the last of the two leaders to be asked around the furlong marker and proved best under strong urging. MACABE'S GOLD chased the pace on the inside, saved ground on the turn, came under a drive in upper stretch, lacked optimal room to the inside of RIVERBOAT BANDIT, slipped through inside that rival in the final sixteenth and finished willingly for the place. KNOT FLOYD chased the pace on the outside, raced three to four wide on the turn, pursued the two leaders in upper stretch and finished willingly for the show. RIVERBOAT BANDIT broke out at the start, contested the pace on the inside of HERECOMESBERT while off the rail, was set down in upper stretch, battled into the final furlong and was outfinished then just missed the minor awards. BRASSY BOY was ridden along behind the leading group, went three wide on the turn, swung five wide into the stretch and also finished willingly. KAT'S COURT was urged along while just off the pace, raced off the rail on the turn and tired. BURN RATE brushed with a rival at the start then dropped back, fell well behind the field, saved ground on the turn, angled out in upper stretch and trailed.
