**Footnotes**

PRIME CUVEE was well rated while setting the pace a bit off the rail, responded well when set down in upper stretch and held under strong urging. PADDLE HEELS was taken in hand, saved ground on the first turn, was reserved off the pace, moved closer while inside on the far turn, was asked at the top of the stretch, moved out while pursuing the winner and finished willingly for the place. HUSSLE FOR RUSSELL was rated just behind the pacesetter while on the inside, came off the rail in the vicinity of the five-sixteenths pole, was asked at the top of the stretch, chased past the three-sixteenths pole, drifted out near the furlong marker and tired while clear for the show. STRING ATTACK settled towards the rear while on the inside, saved ground on the turns and improved position. KING SCOTT'S CALL settled towards the rear while off the rail, was urged along on the far turn and failed to threaten. LE PRINCE went three then two wide on the first turn, settled in fourth position, was ridden along while three to four wide on the far turn, shifted five wide at the top of the stretch and came up empty. BIGANTLERS went three wide on the first turn, tracked the pace, raced four then three wide on the far turn, was asked near the quarter-pole, chased briefly then also came up empty. RUSTOWN HERO was last away, went three wide on the first turn, lagged at the back, was urged along while three wide on the far turn, swung seven wide into the stretch and never reached contention. THUNDER'S STAR bobbled at the start, went three then two wide on the first turn, settled in the middle of the field, was urged along while three wide on the far turn, shifted five wide at the top of the stretch and failed to respond. LOOZIANA BOY went three to four wide on the first turn, settled on the outside, was urged along while four wide on the far turn, floated six wide into the stretch and also failed to respond.
