Footnotes

PREMO'S STAR raced off the rail on the first turn, contested the pace, moved clear near the half-mile pole, was asked passing the five-sixteenths pole, accelerated further clear leaving the far turn and drew off under strong urging. BLESSED MOON settled on the inside, chased on the far turn, came off the rail at the top of the stretch, moved into second position, drifted out in the final furlong and was second best. ALL HER DUE shifted four wide late on the initial turn, moved up with six furlongs to run, raced just off the pace while on the outside, was urged along while three wide on the far turn, came four wide into the stretch and was best of the rest. FASIG GIRL went three wide on the first turn, moved up to take the lead inside the three-quarter pole, lost the lead nearing the half-mile pole, chased while off the rail on the far turn, came three wide into the stretch and tired. FREE SPIRIT ROSE broke out at the start, went four wide on the first turn, settled on the outside, was ridden along while three wide on the far turn, angled out sharply inside the quarter-pole and failed to threaten. HOT SASSY CAT was a bit eager while inside on the first turn, dropped back entering the backstretch, fell to the rear, saved ground while urged along on the far turn and failed to respond. SHORT 'N CURLY raced off the rail on the first turn, was urged some on the backstretch, came up empty on the far turn and retreated.
