THE DEUCE IS LOOSE broke very quickly, raced off the rail on the first turn, set the pace through solid fractions, was challenged midway through the far turn, shook off LAFOURCHE at the top of the stretch, came under the whip shortly thereafter and held under strong urging. ORDINARY TIME saved ground on the first turn, lingered well back in the field, advanced three wide on the far turn and finished willingly for the place. LAFOURCHE raced three wide on the first turn, tracked the pace on the outside, made a bid midway through the far turn, lost touch with the winner in upper stretch and weakened while clear for the show. COCOA'S KNOCKOUT bumped with a rival at the start, lagged well back in the field, was in tight against the rail near the seven-sixteenths pole and failed to threaten. SCORPION PLACE raced three then two wide on the first turn, lingered well back in the field, went two then three wide on the far turn and was no factor. HUSTLIN JOHNNY was caught four wide on the first turn, settled on the outside, was ridden along while three then two wide on the far turn and came up empty. PORTO BERMUDA bumped with a rival at the start, dropped in on the first turn, was urged some on the backstretch and retreated.
