Footnotes

MAGIC DE NASKRA set the clear pace while well rated, was asked after being headed near the three-sixteenths pole, battled determinedly towards the inside, regained the lead inside the sixteenth-pole and prevailed under strong handling. GOSPEL LESSON settled on the outside, advanced quickly while three wide on the far turn, came four wide into the stretch, rallied to the lead near the three-sixteenths pole, led into the final sixteenth but lost the advantage to the winner and missed. BAUERS GOT HOURS came out at the start but was quickly corrected, settled on the inside, was asked in the vicinity of the five-sixteenths pole, moved out while under the whip in upper stretch and finished willingly to just get the show. ATTRACTIVE RIDE was taken under a good hold, raced behind the leader while under restraint, was asked near the five-sixteenths pole, made a bid at the top of the stretch, battled into the final sixteenth and was outfinished then just missed the show. ELEVEN FINAL FOURS raced three wide on the first turn, settled towards the rear, was roused while off the rail on the far turn, swung out at the top of the stretch, moved further to the outside while under a drive and lacked the needed kick. KENNESSEY settled towards the back, raced off the rail on the turns and failed to threaten.
