### Footnotes

TRULY LUCKY sped clear after the start, dictated terms while a bit off the rail, responded well when asked in upper stretch and proved much the best under strong urging. AFTER THE STORM dropped back on the inside, moved out leaving the backstretch, raced three wide on the turn, came five wide into the stretch and finished willingly for the place. WILDCAT ALY was away awkwardly, settled on the outside, moved closer while three to four wide on the turn and failed to rally while up for the show. OUR SASSY TEN was well placed towards the inside, saved ground on the turn, moved out a bit at the top of the stretch and lacked the needed response. BIORRA settled off the pace, dropped back while off the rail on the turn and failed to threaten. BERRY VALID tracked the pace on the outside, chased two to three wide on the turn and tired.
