Footnotes

BURN RATE raced three wide on the first turn, settled off the pace, moved closer while three to four wide on the far turn, gained the lead in upper stretch, edged clear into the final furlong and held while drifting out late. AUSTIN NINER raced three wide on the first turn, lingered well back in the field, advanced three then four wide on the far turn, drifted inward in upper stretch and finished willingly for the place. JUSTIN TIME BANDIT settled on the inside, came off the rail on the far turn, held a good striking position into the stretch but weakened while able to get the show. RUNTOTHELIGHT bumped with a rival at the start, settled in the middle of the field while saving ground, moved closer on the far turn, shifted around a rival outside the quarter-pole, moved out at the top of the stretch and failed to rally. DISCO BID bumped with a rival at the start, raced inside on the first turn, settled well off the pace, moved closer while off the rail on the far turn, swung out at the top of the stretch and came up empty. BIG BOB contested the pace on the inside, was taken back behind

PEABERRY early on the backstretch, prompted that rival on the outside, made a bid on the far turn, led into the stretch then tired. GENEROUS OFFER raced three wide on the first turn, lagged towards the rear, raced inside on the final turn and was no factor. DONNASWALKINDREAM brushed with a rival at the start, raced four wide on the first turn, settled near the middle of the field, was urged along while three to four wide on the far turn and had nothing left. BEST IDEA LOVER was forwardly placed in the field, chased three wide on the far turn and faded. PEABERRY brushed with a rival at the start, contested the pace while three then two wide on the first turn, moved clear early on the backstretch, lost the lead near the five-sixteenths pole and stopped. PROMISING LIFE saved ground on both turns and was outrun. C. MCHALE broke outward and bumped with a rival, raced well back in the field, went three to four wide on the far turn and showed little.
