Footnotes

TWO LEFT SHOES showed good speed, set the pace under pressure, vied inside on the turn, inched clear when set down in upper stretch and was fully extended to last under strong handling. BIG CHIEF DEKE was ridden along towards the front, chased three wide on the turn, pursued the winner determinedly in the stretch and just missed. TOUGH OPERATOR showed good speed, pressed the winner on the outside, vied into upper stretch then tired

while able to get the show. SECOND LION was urged along while off the pace, raced off the rail on the turn and lacked the needed response. SHAVE AND PAVE was urged along while off the pace, raced three wide on the turn and also lacked the needed response. DEWBERRY was taken up multiple times while racing awkwardly along the inside, saved ground on the turn, angled out in upper stretch and failed to menace. REED'S STEED was ridden along on the outside, went four wide on the turn and failed to rally. FABULOUS FAB was ridden along in the front half of the field, saved ground on the turn and came up empty. BOLD JOHN was urged along towards the back, raced three wide on the turn, dropped in a bit at the top of the stretch and failed to threaten. CROWNFORBLESSING was off about three lengths slow, raced well back in the field, saved ground on the turn, moved out in the stretch and was no factor. MAULED was hard ridden on the outside, angled in leaving the backstretch, raced three then four wide on the turn, came five wide into the stretch and failed to respond. TAFT BIG BOY lacked early speed, raced four wide into the turn, dropped to one off the rail shortly thereafter and showed little.
