Footnotes

CAJUN PERSUASION quickly moved clear, set the pace through solid fractions, remained clear while drifting out in the stretch, drifted out more severely late and just held under strong urging. LEESTOWN GIFT settled just off the pace, dropped back near the seven-sixteenths pole, raced inside on the turn, shifted four wide at the top of the stretch, rallied on the outside, was carried out some late and just missed. YUKON BANDIT was urged along while off the pace, raced two then three wide on the turn, moved out six wide at the top of the stretch and finished willingly for the show. TAMBO'S PUMPKIN threw his head at the start, moved up on the outside, chased three then two wide on the turn and tired. STEELY RAN bumped with a rival at the start, was urged along on the outside, advanced three to four wide on the turn, chased in upper stretch and lacked the needed kick. VICAR OF LA chased the pace, dropped back near the seven-sixteenths pole, raced off the rail on the turn, came out five wide at the top of the stretch and lacked the needed response. MARK SAFELY bumped with STEELY RAN at the start then was in tight, was ridden along at the rear of the field, raced near the inside on the turn, swung four wide at the top of the stretch and failed to threaten.
