Footnotes

MEZCAL VIBE came away in front, set the pace under some pressure, lost the lead passing the five-sixteenths pole, was asked in upper stretch, regained the lead outside the sixteenth-pole and proved best under strong handling. THUNDER HARBOR was bumped in the hindquarters at the start, prompted the pace on the outside, took the lead passing the five-sixteenths pole, was asked in upper stretch, led into the final furlong, lost the advantage outside the sixteenth-pole and was outfinished while clear for the place. BIGIN was forced out at the start, settled just off the pace while on the outside, dropped back near the seven-sixteenths pole, was roused while off the rail on the turn, swung four wide into the stretch, moved further to the outside and finished willingly for the show. FIFTY FIVE SOUTH came out at the start, was rated off the pace, went three wide on the turn, came under a drive in upper stretch and lacked the needed response. WARRENS HEIGHTS bobbled at the start then bumped the hindquarters of THUNDER HARBOR, settled at the rear, raced inside on the turn and failed to rally. ADMIRAL NELSON broke about three lengths slow, moved up towards the inside, saved ground early on the turn then came off the rail, was asked for his best in upper stretch and came up empty. (Rail at 20 Feet)
