### Footnotes

LADY TAKUM never far back, came inside around the turn, angled out for the drive, drifted in a bit and got up late. CAPOTE WEST moved clear early, responded when collared by IDOITMYWAY nearing the drive, shook clear a furlong out and then could not hold on. IDOITMYWAY close up from early on, loomed outside CAPOTE WEST nearing the drive, was switched out when in tight inside the final furlong and then hung. ORANGE CRUSH raced inside and lacked a finish. ES VERDAD raced wide and could make little impact. BANYAN STREET improved position. IRISH FIGHT showed little. SOUSAPHONE raced wide and was no real threat. SMOLDERING QUEEN tired.
