Footnotes

HURRICANE DENTON settled behind the leading group, went two then three wide on the turn, came four wide into the stretch, closed gradually while lugging in ever so slightly and surged past the leader late under good handling. GREAT BAM brushed with a rival at the start, was well placed on the outside, raced three wide on the turn, was asked near the five-sixteenths pole, drifted in under right hand urging while making a bid near the furlong marker, came in a bit further and bumped with BONESINABOX near the sixteenth-pole, held the lead late but was caught. MIKEY B broke outward and bumped with a rival, contested the pace between horses, vied inside on the turn, dueled with BONESINABOX in the stretch, bumped with that rival passing the sixteenth-pole, surged back gamely late and missed. BONESINABOX bumped with a rival at the start, contested the pace on the outside, vied outside on the turn, dueled with MIKEY B in the stretch, was bumped by GREAT BAM near the sixteenth-pole then forced into MIKEY B and weakened. PARKWAY SAM pressed the pace on the inside while under some right-handed encouragement, dropped back leaving the backstretch, was urged along while saving ground on the turn and weakened. SAN PACIFICO dropped well behind the field, saved ground on the turn and trailed. Following a stewards' inquiry, GREAT BAM was disqualified from second and placed fourth for interference near the sixteenth-pole.
