FLAGER (ARG) unhurried, circled foes nearing the drive, finished big and was along in time. DUE TO WIN AGAIN settled off the rail, continued outside to rally, loomed but did not have enough late. GIST settled in the back until before the drive, swung outside turning for home and closed late. SALTY FARMA close up from early on, bid outside COMALAGOLD midway down the backstretch, shook clear in upper stretch and then faltered late. ACADEMIC ANGEL within striking distance, split foes in upper stretch, angled inward but was out kicked. MEXICAN MOONLIGHT between foes, lacked the needed kick when asked. COMALAGOLD got clear early, was headed around the second turn and then faded late. TRANSITION TIME raced inside and was no real threat. PALACE ROYALE (IRE) close up until the drive and gave way.
