**Footnotes**

LEE CITY tracked the pace on the outside, engaged the leader on the turn, shook clear in upper stretch and drew away under strong urging. NANIE'S CHEROKEE showed good natural speed, set the pace while in hand, vied inside on the turn, failed to match strides with the winner in upper stretch and tired while able to hold the place. CREME DE CACAO raced just off the pace on the outside, ranged up while three wide and under some urging on the far turn, floated four wide into the stretch and weakened then missed the place. U BELONG TO ME settled towards the back, was asked to go between rivals near the three-eighths pole, steadied approaching the five-sixteenths pole and failed to rally. GREEN BIKINI settled off the pace, raced three wide while between rivals on the turn, was asked near the five-sixteenths pole and came up empty. DAWN'S TRIBUTE broke outward at the start, raced towards the rear of the field on the outside, went four wide on the turn and failed to threaten. BURNINGRICH broke outward at the start, was urged along towards the back, went three wide on the turn, moved out near the three-sixteenths pole and was no factor. IM A SALTY BELFAST settled just off the pace while in an uncomfortable position between rivals, was urged along while off the rail on the turn and had nothing left. LUCKY SKAT was well placed just off the pace, dropped back abruptly leaving the backstretch, was in tight while retreating near the five-sixteenths pole and faltered.
