Footnotes

GLORIOUS STRIKE broke in at the start, moved up on the first turn, took the lead near the five-eighths pole, vied inside on the far turn, responded well when set down in upper stretch, battled with ROAD TO THE RING while under strong right hand urging, switched to a left-handed whip inside the sixteenth-pole and proved best under strong handling. ROAD TO THE RING went four then three wide on the first turn, settled on the outside, moved closer with a half-mile to run, ranged up while three wide on the far turn, made a four wide bid at the top of the stretch, drifted in near the three-sixteenths pole, dueled on the outside of the winner and was outfinished while able to get the place. WHEEMAWAY settled off the pace, inched closer with a half-mile to run, bided his time on the far turn, was asked inside the quarter-pole, came between rivals in upper stretch and finished willingly for the show. A MILLION FIELDS broke four or five lengths behind the field, saved ground on the first turn, passed a rival nearing the half-mile pole, advanced three then four wide on the far turn, came under a drive in upper stretch and lacked the needed response. METAIRIE saved ground on the first turn, was reserved off the pace, went two then three wide on the far turn, dropped in at the top of the stretch and also lacked the needed response. KAIZER TOP raced three wide on the first turn, moved up to contest the pace on the outside, vied into upper stretch then gave way. SELL IT settled towards the rear, saved ground on the turns and failed to threaten. HOURCHANGINGFUTURE moved to a clear early lead, raced inside on the first turn, lost the advantage near the five-eighths pole, dropped back near the half-mile pole, was urged along while inside on the far turn and dropped out.
