PIOUS PREACHER went straight to the front and opened a clear lead, raced inside on the first turn, came well off the rail on the backstretch, vied off the rail on the far turn, floated three wide passing the quarter-pole, responded well in the stretch and gamely prevailed under strong urging. FIRST TO BINGO went two to three wide on the first turn, settled on the outside, moved closer with a half-mile to run, made a bid while three wide on the far turn, came four wide into the stretch, drifted out nearing the eighth-pole, battled willingly in the final furlong and missed. ALBIN went four wide on the first turn, was reserved on the outside, ranged up while four wide on the far turn, came five wide into the stretch, was put to a drive while well out in the course and lacked the needed kick while clear for the show. TIGHT GRIP raced three wide on the first turn, settled in the middle of the field, was roused while off the rail on the far turn and lacked the needed response. JOSHUA REYNOLDS settled towards the rear of the field, raced three wide on the far turn, drifted off some in upper stretch and failed to rally. B'WANAGOLDMINE was unhurried at the back of the field, lost action for a stride near the five-sixteenths pole and failed to threaten. HURRICANE DAY settled on the inside, saved ground on the turns and failed to threaten. ELUSIVE COMMANDER followed the leader from second, moved closer with a half-mile to run, dropped back while inside on the far turn and came up empty. (Rail at 10 Feet)
