ZARBYSTEPPEES within striking distance, angled out four wide for the drive, gained the lead a sixteenth out and held SHEER SABLE safe. SHEER SABLE unhurried while outrun, found her best stride and was getting to the winner. HOLLY BEACH sprinted to a clear early lead, was clear for the drive and weakened late. ITSMISSBAGTOYOU brushed the side of the gate at the break, recovered, rallied and hung. SAN BAG showed speed from the inside and weakened late. SUMMER SAUCE off last, improved position outside. ZIP CODE settled and failed to menace. MARTHA MAE was outrun. PASS THE SAUCE showed little and was not a threat. BEAULAGRA forwardly placed, offered her best a quarter out and then drifted out while weakening. CAMDEN SUMMER stopped badly and was not abused.
