OKAYA sprinted clear quickly, remained clear for the drive, got overtaken before the final sixteenth and was game for second. KIVI close up from early on, lacked a rally. BEAU HAPPY moved to the rail early, continued inside until before the drive, eased out and was no real threat. AUTUMN ACCENT was outrun. LEGENDARY LASS saved ground to no avail. QUICK ADVICE showed little. SAVORY was never dangerous. NO BETTER CHANCE tired.
