Footnotes

NEED A NAME close up off the leader, came inside around the second turn, was eased out entering the drive, rallied determinedly and proved clearly best. CLUB TEJANO three wide around the first turn, held a forward position off the rail, moved up outside ATTRACTIVE RIDE midway around the second turn, gained the edge nearing the final furlong, then was no match late. ATTRACTIVE RIDE cleared to the inside early to set the pace, held the lead to the drive, then faltered once headed. SKEPTIC inside to the drive, was steered out, then lacked the needed finish. GETAPOSSETOGETHER three wide around the first turn, moved to the inside after entering the backstretch, continued inside and had no response. TROUTDALE under stout restraint early, was outrun. WHO U LIKE four wide around the first turn and backstretch, retreated and was eased.
