MILES HEIR allowed the pace to go early, collared the leaders from the outside turning for home, drew off down the lane while drifting out. I AM PRECISION raced off the early pace out in the strip, four wide through the turn, proved no match for the winner in the drive but was game for the place. WHY NOT BE PERFECT settled off the pace, improved position while between foes into the lane, outfinished for the place. WILD AGAIN SOUL crowded at the start, raced well back off the rail, shifted out, improved with some belated interest. KNEB WORTH crowded at the start, raced back, improved a bit while never dangerous. NINEWAYHIT pressed for three furlongs, challenged off the inside late in the turn, gave way final furlong. THEY CALL HIM EL within striking distance early, fell back in the turn and went evenly through the stretch. SAINTLY TALE steadied at the start, remained back. AUDITORIUM never a threat. SEVEN SHOOTER narrowly set the pace for three furlongs, stopped when headed.
