CONNER CAN was bumped at the start, raced four then three wide on the first turn, settled towards the back, rallied three then four wide on the far turn, swept to the lead in upper stretch, edged clear into the final furlong and proved best under steady urging. BUBBLING SPRINGS raced three wide on the first turn, settled in the middle of the field, ranged up without much encouragement while three wide on the far turn, made a bid near the five-sixteenths pole, was asked after being passed in upper stretch and was second best. REGAL SOUL raced three wide on the first turn, moved up on the backstretch, stalked the leader on the outside, was asked to go after that rival in the vicinity of the five-sixteenths pole, made a bid between horses at the top of the stretch but was outfinished while able to secure the show. ALVIN AND DAVID broke outward and bumped with a rival, dropped to the rail midway through the first turn, lingered near the back, raced inside on the far turn, moved out in upper stretch and lacked the needed response. WAR REGENT came away in good order, set the pace while eager and under a snug hold, was given his head on the far turn, lost the lead at the top of the stretch and gave way. INVISIBLE FORCE raced inside on the first turn, dropped well behind the field, came three wide into the stretch and failed to threaten. STRATEGIC WEAPON raced off the rail on the first turn, moved up early on the backstretch, tracked the pace, came up empty while two then three wide on the far turn, drifted four wide into the stretch and stopped.
