**Footnotes**

DESSY close up, rallied three wide for the drive and got up late. GELFAND brushed just after the break, stalked GOOD FIGHT from early on, bit outside that one in upper stretch, got clear but was no match for the winner late. GOOD FIGHT sprinted clear quickly, was headed by GELFAND before mid stretch, then while no match for the top two was best of the rest. STORM GRANT inside to nearing the drive, eased out and was no real threat. STORM EXPERT came in at the start bothering inner foes, was kept widest down the backstretch, then improved position. MAY SING THE BLUES forced in at the break, moved in a bit around the turn, then could make little impact. IVORY BILL devoid speed, was eased out around the turn, then came widest in the drive. PASS BY THE HOUSE brushed at the break, was unhurried while out footed and lacked a rally. SILENT COUNT forced in at the break, settled off the rail early, crossed to the inside around the turn, then had no response. NMYBELLY forced out at the break by BIGLUCKY'S HOPE, was not a factor. SEE RED brushed early, was always back. BIGLUCKY'S HOPE veered out at the break bothering outer foes, recovered to show early foot, then gave way.
