DOO WAP DADDY pressured the leader from the outside, took over second turn, drew out, kept to task. MIDNIGHT CURFEW settled behind the leaders, came on the outside, no match winner, up late for the place. SUPERSEDE lacked speed, began to advance off the inside in the second turn, between foes late, just up show. STORM GRANT broke alertly, sprinted clear, set the pace while attempting to rate, faltered. TICKET TO VEGAS off slowly, raced back, improved position while not having enough for the place or show. MACS PASS lacked speed, came five wide out of the final turn, passed tiring foes while remaining well out in the strip. MIDNITE SHARKBITE settled off the pace while saving ground, failed to respond. HIT GOLD DIRECTLY off slowly, remained back throughout. I. R. A DIAMOND was finished after a half. SONNY'S MAN forwardly placed in the early going, staged a steady retreat.
