CLEVER THIRTEEN showed good speed and set the pace, vied inside on the turn, battled gamely with OURAGANS ICON into the final sixteenth then inched clear under strong urging. OURAGANS ICON bumped with a rival at the start, tracked the pace, engaged the leader on the turn, battled with that rival into the final sixteenth and was outfinished while able to hold the place. HUNT FOR CANDIE broke inward and bumped with a rival, settled on the outside, raced three wide on the turn, moved out once straightened for the drive and finished willingly for the show. MIKEY'S SISTER was forwardly placed on the outside, chased three wide on the turn and tired. IT'S A ECHO RUMOR was bumped on both sides at the start, raced near the back of the field, went three wide on the turn and failed to threaten. A LITTLE TRIBUTE settled off the pace while off the rail, checked near the three-eighths pole and dropped back then failed to threaten. TWELVE STEPPER bumped with a rival at the start, raced four wide on the turn and failed to respond. POLITE AND COZY came out a bit at the start, was urged along on the outside, moved closer while four wide on the turn but came up empty. ST. PATSY broke inward at the start, took an awkward stride and steadied along the rail early, raced just off the pace near the inside, saved ground on the turn and had nothing left. CLARAS SUNRISE bumped with a rival at the start and was last away, settled towards the inside, appeared uncomfortable near the half-mile pole, moved

up inside her entymate, checked sharply near the three-eighths pole and dropped to the rear, came three wide into the stretch and was no factor.
