Footnotes

PERFECT WHISTLE settled on the inside while in the middle of the field, came off the rail late on the far turn, was asked after turning into the stretch, split rivals near the three-sixteenths pole, chased the runner-up under the whip, closed well to get the lead inside the sixteenth-pole and prevailed under strong urging. LORI'S DARLING lugged out into the first turn, brushed with a rival at that point, set the pace through moderate fractions, lugged out a bit on the far turn, was guided around that bend with left rein pressure, responded well when set down in upper stretch, held a clear advantage into the final furlong, led into the final sixteenth but was caught. PUMMILL went four wide early on the first turn then dropped to the three path, settled in the middle of the field, was urged along while off the rail early on the far turn, shifted four wide nearing the quarter-pole and got up for the show. SALUTE THE L T J G brushed with LORI'S DARLING while four wide early on the first turn then dropped in, stalked the pace on the outside, chased three wide on the far turn and tired. SO RUSTON was taken back early, bumped with a rival while two to three wide on the first turn, was well placed just off the pace, raced inside on the far turn, was asked at the top of the stretch, chased into the final furlong and weakened. INDYWAYWEGO settled well back in the field, saved ground on both turns and failed to threaten. LUKIE JOE settled towards the rear while off the pace, was urged along while two to three wide on the far turn, came between rivals in upper stretch and showed little. KAT BITE went three wide on the first turn, settled off the pace, was urged along while five then six wide on the far turn and never reached contention. BROTHER MAXWELL bumped with a rival at the start, went four wide on the first turn, settled on the outside, advanced five

wide on the far turn while hard ridden then came up empty. PORTLY bumped with an opponent at the start, lugged out into the first turn, raced five to six wide on that bend, raced off the pace, was taken up some while four wide early on the far turn, moved to five wide while dropping back and capitulated. ARCTIC MONARCHOS broke about three to four lengths slow, lagged at the rear and was no factor. RISKY FOREST went five then four wide early on the first turn, bumped with a rival while three wide late on that bend, settled off the pace, was urged along while three then four wide on the far turn and faded.
