Footnotes

AKA LILY'S LAD was well rated while setting the pace, controlled the action through the far turn, responded well when set down in upper stretch, drew off into the final furlong and proved much the best while wandering about. HOWELL PARK went three wide on the first turn, moved closer with five furlongs to run, chased three wide on the far turn and secured the place while no match for the winner. BUBBLING SPRINGS settled off the pace, moved closer with five furlongs to run, advanced on the inside near the half-mile pole, chased on the far turn and tired while able to get the show. BRAZILIONAIRE was taken under a very strong hold while into the bit, raced under a vigorous hold with the rider standing almost straight in the air, steadied late on the first turn, tracked the pace, went two then three wide early on the far turn, moved to four wide near the five-sixteenths pole and came up empty. CAJUN CONQUEST lagged well behind the field, was ridden along on the far turn, swung out near the quarter-pole and failed to threaten. BUCKWILD went four wide on the first turn, settled on the outside, was ridden along while four then five wide on the far turn, drifted seven wide into the stretch and faltered.
