CLEVER THIRTEEN settled on the inside, was roused on the far turn, moved out while gaining in upper stretch, closed fast to get the lead outside the sixteenth-pole then powered away under left hand urging. LEE CITY raced off the rail on the first turn, set the pace, was asked for her best in upper stretch, lost the lead outside the sixteenth-pole and proved no match while clear for the place. NANA KNOWS settled on the outside, was roused on the far turn, moved out in upper stretch and was best of the rest. COCO'S SHADOW was away awkwardly, lingered well back in the field and failed to threaten. RED MOON CAT settled towards the rear, went three wide on the far turn, came four wide into the stretch and was no factor. ROYAL MADAME bumped with a rival after the start, went five wide on the first turn, tracked down the backstretch, chased on the far turn, drifted out near the three-sixteenths pole then back in again and tired. NIKITA'S SECRET was taken back before the first turn, dropped to the inside, saved ground on both turns and also failed to threaten. BERNICE SPECIAL broke out and bumped with ROYAL MADAME, lugged out some while four wide on the first turn, dropped back while into the bit and racing with her mouth wide open, bolted near the five-sixteenths pole and was eased but walked off. (Rail at 20 Feet)
