LUCKY TRADITION went three wide on the first turn, was forwardly placed on the outside, made a bid while three wide on the far turn, came under a drive in upper stretch, battled with FANTASTICAL into the final furlong then edged clear under strong urging. FANTASTICAL broke out at the start, tracked the pace, made a bid while between rivals on the far turn, was put to a drive in upper stretch, battled with the winner into the final furlong and was outfinished then was unsaddled on the far turn but walked off. COMMODORE WAY went four wide on the first turn, settled on the outside, was urged along while four wide on the far turn, moved closer into upper stretch, chased into the final furlong and finished willingly to just miss the place. RICKY BOBBY was reserved on the inside, came under urging on the far turn, saved ground into the stretch, came between horses passing the three-sixteenths pole and also finished willingly. ALVIN AND DAVID was reserved while off the inside, came under urging on the far turn and lacked the needed kick. BROTHERS NICHOLAS settled while off the inside, was hard ridden on the far turn, swung four wide into the stretch and lacked the needed response. GOWDEN MILE saved ground on the first turn, was reserved towards the back, went three wide on the far turn, swung five wide into the stretch and failed to threaten. WHAT SECRET was hustled from the start, set the pace on the inside, lost the lead passing the five-sixteenths pole and gave way.
