Footnotes

SOUL SACRIFICE went three wide on the first turn, was reserved off the pace, waited under a hold while three wide on the far turn, shifted five wide and was asked at the top of the stretch, rallied on the outside, closed well into the final furlong, drifted in while coming to the lead, grabbed the lead in the vicinity of the sixteenth-pole then moved clear under good handling. SHERTZER broke out at the start, went four wide on the first turn, settled on the far outside, was roused while four wide on the far turn, drifted out a bit in upper stretch and finished willingly for the place. KAYOU set the clear pace, was set down in upper stretch, held a clear advantage into the final furlong but was overtaken while able to get the show. DEW DROP KID raced inside early on the first turn then came off the rail, tracked the pace on the outside, inched closer on the far turn, was asked near the quarter-pole, chased in upper stretch and weakened. ARTILLERY saved ground on the first turn, lagged at the rear of the field, shifted three wide midway through the far turn, swung five wide into the stretch and failed to threaten. JEFF saved ground on the first turn, settled in the front half of the field, came under urging near the half-mile pole and

failed to respond. SCRIVCO was reserved on the inside, moved up near the five-eighths pole, saved ground through the far turn and came up empty. LEMONY went two to three wide on the first turn, settled on the outside, was ridden along while three wide on the far turn and also came up empty. HELICOPTER ACE stumbled at the start, lagged near the back, went three to four wide on the far turn and was no factor.
