Footnotes

RING NECKED tracked the pace on the outside, made a bid while three wide on the turn, edged clear in upper stretch, extended the advantage under the whip, continued under the whip until inside the sixteenth-pole then was eased up late while much the best. SILVER ROCKET MAN broke a bit slow, went two to three wide on the first turn, was reserved at the rear, raced inside early on the far turn while moving closer then came off the rail, was roused while four wide late on that bend, came five wide into the stretch and safely secured the place. MARTY THE MONSTER was eased back between rivals early, raced off the rail on the first turn, was reserved off the pace, moved closer with a half-mile to run, shifted three wide early on the far turn while urged along, came four wide into the stretch and lacked the needed response while able to get the show. CORINTHIANS SECRET raced inside on the first turn, was well placed just off the pace while inside of an opponent, made a bid between horses on the far turn, vied into upper stretch then weakened. MY SMOOTH TALKER set the pace on the inside, was asked near the five-sixteenths pole, lost the lead coming to the quarter-pole and gave way. TIZ A STAR went four wide on the first turn, settled on the outside, was ridden along while four wide on the far turn and faltered. CAJUN CHROME was unruly in the gate, went three wide on the first turn, settled off the pace, came up empty on the far turn and retreated.
