MIDGE TOO clear early, repulsed a bid by MRS. MAC before the drive, opened up nearing mid stretch and proved best while kept to the task. EASTERN SUN unhurried, saved ground around the second turn and closed gamely while along for second. AUTOBESARAH settled early, saved ground around the second turn, was steered out in upper stretch and got up for third. MRS. MAC stalked MIDGE TOO from early on, bid outside that one before the drive and then weakened late. PRIZED AMBERPRO forwardly placed, had no rally. DEVIL'S DUCHESS close up along the rail, swung out for the drive and then faded. WILD SQUAW reserved early, made a four wide run around the second turn and flattened out. HIGH HOPES IRISH saved ground and had no rally. LA SALSA was always back. ANOTHER GREY LADY dropped back steadily and was not abused.
