Footnotes

FASS FEAT forwardly placed off the rail, bid three wide around the turn, surged clear before mid stretch and proved best while kept to the task. TORTUGA STRAITS close up early, dropped back a bit around the turn and then came again to get up for second. MAGIC SUNSET well back early, rallied outside and was along for the show. POWER SURGE forwardly placed off the rail, moved up for the drive and then failed to sustain his bid. MR. BARRACUDA reserved early, eased out for the drive and lacked a late punch. CAPTAIN BUDDY was no real threat. HEELBOLT showed speed to the drive and then faded.

NOWANDFOREVERMORE moved to the rail before the turn, continued inside until midway around the turn, was eased out and then lacked a response. LIQUID SILVER saved ground too no avail. WHO'S ZARY NOW was outrun. THE Q CLUB clear early, got collared around the turn, was headed in upper stretch and then gave way. ZARB'S DAHAR showed little. STORM HEAT wide early, came four wide around the turn and then flattened out. BRUSH WITH DANGER off last, trailed from early on and was eased. STORM HEAT RAN FOR PURSE MONEY ONLY.
