Footnotes

HAMMERS TERROR stalked the pace on the outside, drew even with the leader on the far turn, inched clear at the top of the stretch, drew away under a left-handed whip and held well while under hand urging in the final sixteenth. ADENA'S CHANCE raced inside on the first turn, moved up near the five-eighths pole, steadied off heels outside the half-mile pole, chased inside on the far turn, moved out near the furlong marker and finished willingly for the place. M ONE broke in the air, spotted the field around four lengths, lagged well behind, moved out while gaining on the far turn, swung seven wide into the stretch, moved past several rivals on the outside and earned the show. WHISTLE INCLUDED settled while off the rail, was urged along between rivals on the far turn and weakened. DANGER STORM went three wide on the first turn, moved up on the outside, was urged along while four then five wide on the far turn, drifted six wide into the stretch and came up empty. SKY ALERT went three wide on the first turn, settled on the outside, moved closer with a half-mile to run, chased three then four wide on the far turn and tired. HARD NOSED set the pace, vied inside on the winner on the far turn and stopped.
