MEMORIES MADE raced three wide on the first turn, was well placed just off the pace, took the lead while inside on the far turn, edged clear coming to the quarter-pole and drew away under steady urging. BREEZE SHOW went four then three wide on the first turn, contested the pace, chased three wide on the far turn and narrowly earned the place while no match for the winner. KISS AND A PECK broke about two lengths behind the field, was unhurried towards the rear, saved ground on the turns, moved off the rail near the furlong marker and narrowly missed the place. COAMING was taken in hand early, dropped to the inside on the first turn, was reserved off the pace, saved ground into the stretch and lacked the needed response. RECONCILIATION reared at the start, broke about two lengths behind the field, went two to three wide on the turns and failed to threaten. TERRINE settled on the inside, moved out near the seven-sixteenths pole, went four to five wide on the far turn, dropped to three wide outside the quarter-pole, moved out once straightened for the drive and failed to rally. CLASSY CITY SLEW raced three wide on the first turn, settled off the pace, was roused while off the rail on the far turn and failed to menace. BERYOZKA went four to five wide on the first turn, raced just off the pace, steadied between rivals early on the far turn, was squeezed back a bit, came four wide into the stretch and had nothing left. ELLEGNA broke a bit slow, went two to three wide on the first turn, lagged well behind, went three to

four wide on the far turn and was no factor. MEMORIES OF LUCAS showed good speed, contested the pace, chased on the far turn, was taken up while dropping back at the top of the stretch and tired.
